

Parkside Community Hub offers a wide range of services and training opportunities.

A wide range of courses are available, including:

- Computer courses;
- Function skills in English;
- Function skills in Maths;
- ESOL (English for speakers of other languages).

Our training courses are available to anyone over the age of 18.





English courses (term time only)

A class to gain a recognised qualification up to level two.

English for speakers of other languages (term time only)

Learn or improve your English. Suitable for all levels. Learn at your own pace and gain recognised qualifications.

Maths courses (term time only)

A class to gain a recognised qualification up to level two.

Crèche

Space is available for participants of English and maths courses. Please ask a member of the Hub team when registering.

Tutor lead computer courses

Learn to use computers, or improve your skills. We run a seven week computer course at basic or intermediate levels.

The courses are run by our friendly IT tutor who can answer any questions you may have along the way.

The Hub also has drop in sessions where you can practice your computer skills.
